Re: Brush/Yard Waste Pickup and Removal

Dear Resident,

The Town Brush pile has been permanently closed since August 8th, 2017.

With that said and as you have noticed, The Town of Roanoke is and will continue to pick up and remove brush/yard waste from Town Residents. The normal scheduled curbside pickup is Monday but pickup day may be altered do to emergency issues, Holidays, storm events etc. Brush collection stipulations;

- Normal pruning of trees and bushes will be picked up.
- The Town will pick up no more than 5 yards of brush from any one stop.
- Large volumes of brush from the removal of a tree or trees shall be handled by the Owner or Occupants of the premises.
- The Town will not pick up or handle brush or other debris from the removal of a tree that has been contracted for removal. It shall be the Owner or Occupants responsibility for the removal of such material.

The Town will also pickup residential yard waste. Yard waste stipulations;

- Residential yard waste as a result of landscaping such as grass clippings, brush, leaves and limbs.
- ALL yard waste shall be in paper/recyclable bags and untied/secured.
- There shall be **NO** plastic bags or plastic of any sort inside the paper/recyclable bags.

Unfortunately, yard waste contained in plastic or paper/recyclable bags, mixed with soil, sod, rocks, and trash will **NOT** be collected. Plastic or paper/recyclable bags containing the items referenced above will **NOT** be collected and it will the Owners responsibility to dispose of them.

As a reference/FYI; Huntington County has its own permanent Hazardous Materials Facility, located next to the City of Huntington Landfill-located at 517 S 300 W, Huntington, Indiana 46750. ALL Huntington County Residence are encouraged to utilize the facility. Please take time to visit the county website at <http://www.huntington.in.us/county/departments/index.php?structureid=38> for a list/limits of ALL accepted items, hours of operations, etc. Below is a partial list of hazardous waste limits;

- 220 lbs hazardous and /or other universal waste per month; maximum 660 lbs per year
- 3 cubic yds electronic waste per month; maximum 9 yds per year
- Fl tubes 800 ft per month; maximum 2,400 ft per year
- Paint 220 lbs per month; maximum 660 lbs per year (appx. 50 gal month, 150 yr)
- Unlimited—oil, antifreeze, car batteries
- Twelve (12) car/truck tires per household and per vehicle (on or off the rim)
